



Leaving a Legacy to Travellers' Times Q & A:

By leaving a gift in your Will you can help give future generations of Gypsies and Travellers a voice through Travellers' Times and help protect their heritage.

Making a Will is extremely important - it is the only way of ensuring that your loved ones and the causes you support get the gifts you intend.

There are three main types of legacy you can leave to loved ones and causes:

1. Residuary legacy – a percentage of the value of your estate once all outstanding payments have been made.
2. Pecuniary legacy – This is a gift of a fixed amount of money.
3. Specific legacy – this is a gift of a personal possession such as land, jewellery, china etc.

How do I leave a legacy to Travellers' Times?

When making a Will we recommend that you use a solicitor who has the expertise to advise you and ensure that your wishes are clearly expressed. If you wish to leave a donation to Travellers' Times in your Will your solicitor will be able to advise you how best to do this.

Can I update my existing Will?

Yes, you can update your existing will to include a donation to Travellers' Times via a Codicil.

Adding a Codicil to your Will means that there is no need to change the terms of your current Will. A Codicil simply adds a new instruction to your Will. We recommend that you do this via a solicitor.
